Report

Background

- 1. In the meeting of the Intellectual Development sub-committee under the Management Committee of Hall Education Development Office dated 6 April, 2011, the members agreed to organize hall education courses relating to the presidential election of Taiwan.
- 2. The main idea of the courses would be a study tour to Taiwan to let students experience a presidential election in a democratic society.
- 3. Two hall education courses were designed (HEC-TW-01 & HEC-TW-02). This course included a series of seminars, providing students with the basic knowledge of the development of Taiwan politics.

Objective

4. To let students learn about the democratic development, constitutional system and political culture of Taiwan by providing them with seminars.

Publication and Publicity

- 5. Posters had been put up on all 16 halls and CEDARS office. (Annex 1 3)
- 6. Two bulk emails were sent.
- 7. Posts had been put up on Facebook.

Enrollment

- 8. Thirty-two students were enrolled into this course.

- 13. Participants who joined both this course and the course HEC-TW-02 were divided into 4 groups.
- 14. Each group was required to design a topic to be studied during their visit to Taiwan and was required to prepare a proposal of their study project.
- 15. Each group had presented their proposal in the 4th seminar held on 26 November 2011.

Award

- 16. Students who had completed both this course and the course HEC-TW-02 were given a tour fee deduction of HK\$2,052 plus a certificate of course completion. Students who had done well in their study project were given a certificate of distinction.
- 17. Students who had only completed the course HEC-TW-02 were given the tour fee deduction of HK\$2,052.

Financial Report

- 18. An honorarium of HK\$458 per hour was given to the guest speakers.
- 19. A total of HK\$5,496 was given to the guest speakers:

Report

Background

- 1. In the meeting of the Intellectual Development sub-committee under the Management Committee of Hall Education Development Office dated 6 April, 2011, the members agreed to organize hall education courses relating to the presidential election of Taiwan.
- 2. The main idea of the courses would be a study tour to Taiwan to let students experience a presidential election in a democratic society.
- 3. Two hall education courses were designed (HEC-TW-01 & HEC-TW-02). This course, as an extension of the course HEC-TW-01, included a Taiwan presidential election study tour.

Objective

4. To let students learn about the democratic development, constitutional system and political culture of Taiwan by providing them with experiential learning.

Publicity and publication

- 5. Posters had been put up on all 16 halls and CEDARS office. (Annex 1 3)
- 6. Two bulk emails were sent.
- 7. Posts had been put up on Facebook.

Enrollment

8. Thirty-nine students were enrolled into this course.

Content

Preparation

- 10. Quotation requests were made to Miramar Travel Ltd., Sun Flower Travel Service Ltd. and Xpert Holidays. (Annex 4 6)
- 11. Quotation made by Miramar Travel Ltd was the lowest and it was chosen to be our travel agency.
- 12. Taipei Economic and Cultural Office had given us support in liaison between HEDO and the hosting organization in Taiwan.
- 13. Taiwan Secondary Education Association (中華中等教育學會) was the hosting organization in Taiwan.
- 14. Taiwan Secondary Education Association (中華中等教育學會) had arranged the visits to Kuomintang election head quarter and Democratic Progressive Party election head quarter for us. They had also provided us all information about the election campaign of the presidential election candidates.
- 15. Visiting requests were made directly to TVBS, United Daily News and National Chengji University.

Tour details

- 16. The tour was held from 12 January 2012 to 16 January 2012.
- 17. Participants of the tour included 39 students, the HEDO manager and Prof. Ben Young as the HEDO supervisor.
- 18. Thirty-nine students were divided into 7 groups. One student from each group was appointed as the leader to help checking the attendance of the members.
- 19. The HEDO manager was responsible to maintain the events on schedule.
- 20. Prof. Ben Young was responsible to look after the students.
- 21. Visits to political parties, public opinion research center, press companies, polling center, post election seminar and famous tourist spots were arranged (Annex 7 8)
- 22. A post-tour seminar was held on 3 March 2012, in Assembly Hall, 6D Sassoon Road. Course assignments were presented in this seminar.

Assignment

- 23. Participants who joined both the course HEC-TW-01 and this course were divided into 4 groups. Each group was required to design a topic to be studied during their visit to Taiwan and was required to prepare a proposal of their study project. They had done, during the tour, their study projects which were reported in the post-tour seminar.
- 24. Participants who only joined this course were required to write a diary about the tour and post it on the internet, sharing with the public. They were also required to attend the post tour seminar.

Award

- 25. Students who had completed both the course HEC-TW-01 and this course were given a tour fee deduction of HK\$2,052 plus a certificate of course completion. Students who had done well in their study project were given a certificate of distinction.
- 26. Students who had only completed this course were given the tour fee deduction of HK\$2,052.

Financial Report

- 27. In the budget of the HED Project, HK\$80,000 was allocated for an overseas study tour. This sum was used in this course for the Taiwan study tour.
- 28. Thirty-nine students were enrolled and each student was given a tour fee deduction of HK\$2,052. To ease transaction, two students who purchased flight tickets by their own were given a tour fee deduction of HK\$2,038 instead of HK\$2,052.

$$(HK$2,052 \times 37) + (HK$2,038 \times 2) = HK$80,000$$

- 29. Miramar Travel Ltd. had given discount on the tour fee of the HEDO manager, resulting in his tour fee of HK\$3,393 in total. (Annex 9 10)
- 30. The expenses of this course were as follows:
