Hall Education Course Three:
Training in Tackling Physical and Mental Problem during Orientation
(Course Code: HEC-FAFO)

Course Description

Aim

- 1. To fulfill the HED Project objectives:
 - To enhance student learning experience through hall education.
 - To achieve the university educational aims through hall education particularly in the areas of life-long learning, tackling novel situations, critical self-reflections, upholding personal ethics, intercultural understanding, global citizenship, communication, collaboration, and leadership.

Objectives

- 2. To equip students with proper knowledge and skills in tackling the physical and mental problem of freshmen during orientation.
- 3. To concern the student orientation camp organizers to take precautions in the orientation activity arrangements.

Learning Outcomes

- 4. Understand the importance of responsibility, carefulness and respect of fellow hall-mates.
- 5. Master the techniques of certain safety precautions and first aid skills.
- 6. Know how to deal with students with emotional problems.

Prerequisite

7. None.

Content

- 8. Two training courses will be organized, including one first aid certification course and one training session for senior students in hall on tackling freshmen with emotional problem.
- 9. The first aid certification course will be run by Hong Kong St. John Ambulance.
- 10. The first aid certification course consists of a 4-day training and an examination session.
- 11. The training for senior students in hall on tackling freshmen with emotional problem will be run by the Counseling and Person Enrichment section from CEDARS, HKU.
- 12. The training for senior students in hall on tackling freshmen with emotional problem is a 3-hour training.
- 13. Participants who have completed more than 80% of the first aid certification course with a pass in the examination will be given a certificate by Hong Kong St John Ambulance.
- 14. Participants who have completed the training for senior students in hall on tackling freshmen with emotional problem will be given a certificate by CEDARS.
- 15. All trainings will be conducted in Cantonese. No translation service will be provided.

Assignment

16. Course-related assignments will be given by the instructor during training.

Schedule

- 17. Training of the first aid certification course will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on 3rd, 4th, 5th and 6th July 2012.
- 18. The examination session of the first aid certification course will be held from 2:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on 20th July 2012.
- 19. The training for senior students in hall on tackling freshmen with emotional problem will be held from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on 21st July 2012.

- 20. Applicants should complete the application form (HEC-FAFO-appform) and give it to the P.I.C. of the orientation camp of their halls. The orientation camp P.I.C.s will then send the applications to Mr. Anders Wong, the HEDO Manager.
