Course Description

Aim

- 1. To fulfill the HED Project objectives:
 - To enhance student learning experience through hall education.

Objectives

- 3. To help students prepare for the next Hall Education Course, Taiwan Presidential Election Study Tour 2012.

Content

- 5. Four seminars plus an assignment presentation will be held.
- 6. The topics of the seminars are:
 - The history of Taiwan politics
 - The impact of Taiwan democratic development on Hong Kong
 - The impact of Taiwan democratic development on China
 - Taiwan presidential election 2012 and current situation

Assignment

7. Students are free to form their group of 3 to 6 members.

- 8. Each group is required to create and work on an innovative project related to the Taiwan presidential election 2012.
- 9. The proposal of the project will be presented in the assignment presentation which is held on 26 November 2011. Each proposal will be given a score based on the innovativeness, insight into the topic and the feasibility of the project.
- 10. The report of the project will be presented in February 2012, after the Taiwan presidential election study tour.
- 11. Students who decided to join the study tour are advised to do their project during the trip.
