# (1) Political views of TW Youth and their position in the 2012 election

# First Voters (首投族)


- Age 20 or above are eligible to vote in TW.
- Age 20-24: first time to vote for political elections; persons who had not yet reached 20 in the last election (2008).
- According to the numbers published by the ministry of interior there is about 1.6mil.
- The actual turnout was around 7.5%, thus **1.2mil** represent the number of vote by them. Thus, its proportion in total voters: **8.8**%.

# First Voters (首投族)

- Voters aged between 20-29 is 3.46mil. Thus, The First voters consist of 34% of the Youth group.

# Youth Group in the 2012 election

- The group aged between 20 to 29 is about 3.46mil, and consists about 20% of the total electorate.
- Difficult to predict their attitude for the candidates (Not defined by political color; pan-blue or pan-green), while the attitude of the elder groups are fixed usually.

# Youth Group in the 2012 election

- Excluding those in the military services, almost a half of the First voters (consists 34 % of the group aged between 20-29) are college and university students, and a half of them are already working.
- Economic issues is important for them rather than Political identity issue. Mainly education and employment

# Youth Group in the 2012 election

- The total unemployment rate was about 4.4%, while that of the First voters were around 12.8%, last year (2011)
- Ma's government has successfully reduced the total rate of unemployment proportionately by about 15% compared to the 2010. However, they only reduced that of First voter's group by 0.5%.

### Youth Motivation

- Taiwanese Youth are much more interested in economic issue rather than political issue.
- Political views of the Youth are not fixed according to ideological issue.
- They are influential for the outcome of election, in terms of their proportion in the total electorate.
- DPP supporter are mostly young people

-front man of Taiwan most well known metal band, Chthonic

-GUTS United, an organization that strives to get Taiwanese youth to care about Taiwan's political future



- -the way to make politics accessible to youth is to make it fun, rather than boring and preachy
- something that young people can relate to and enjoy, while imparting a basic message that they can latch onto.

"Globally, the young people don't care too much about political things," Lim laments. "They care more about their own lives, so they don't pay much attention to serious political issues.



Advertisement and measure taken by Political Parties to engage Youth in Politics

- -DPP established a youth group, Freddy Action in 2008
- -Freddy Action designed eye catching promotional products, including stickers, flags and mobile phone straps.
- -" Turn the tide"
- -Gave youth the freedom to carry on their own activities
- -DPP invites Freddy Action representative in meetings to listen to youth demands





-KMT set up three youth groups dedicated to encourage youth participation in the campaign for the presidential election, including the Youth League, the Youth Army and the Youth Unit.

-One of the youth groups, the GMD Youth League was set up in 2004.





-The Youth Army was another election apparatus for the campaign.

It had an all-girl team with about 2,300 to 2,500 female students

- -They were organized into a sub-unit, named "Babes for Ma".
- -"Ten Rifles" was a design team in Mr Ma's election campaign.







Youth and Voluntary Participation in political activities

# Is it really Voluntary?

- Corruption: Generally no incidences of corruption reported to suggest youth induced
- No compulsory voting requirement in law
- Youth and leadership as part of transition

# Areas of volunteering

- Campaign headquarters i.e. DPP and KMT campaign head offices had youthful leadership. Generally more youth witnessed in DPP camp pointing toward pro 'nationalism' sentiments

- Organizing rallies and public mobilisation
- Distribution of campaign materials

# Importance of youth volunteering

- Discernible 'life' to the whole Taiwanese elections. The youth more active and loud thus creating 'electioneering mood'. Good for high turnout.
- Engaged for political transition thus stable Taiwan
- High chances of constructive policy debate in the long term i.e. cross-strait relations/ one-china policy
